




GAIN STARTS FROM THE GUT

AGPs are given to chickens in order to control diseases and also to promote faster growth and improve feed conversion rates. This practice has recently raised concerns regarding emergence of antibiotic resistant strains of bacteria that could potentially spread to humans.
